



In response to widespread power outages that are affecting residents who rely on private wells in the Southbury, Middlebury and Oxford area, **Connecticut Water and Heritage Village Water have opened a free potable water station at Heritage Village in Southbury. The water station is located at Community House Park, 200 Community House Road, Southbury (near Route 67). This is a free service provided to the community.**

All of Connecticut Water/Heritage Village water customers in the area and across the state have had uninterrupted water service from our company due to the emergency generators owned and maintained by the company that power our critical infrastructure even when power is not available through our electric provider, Eversource.

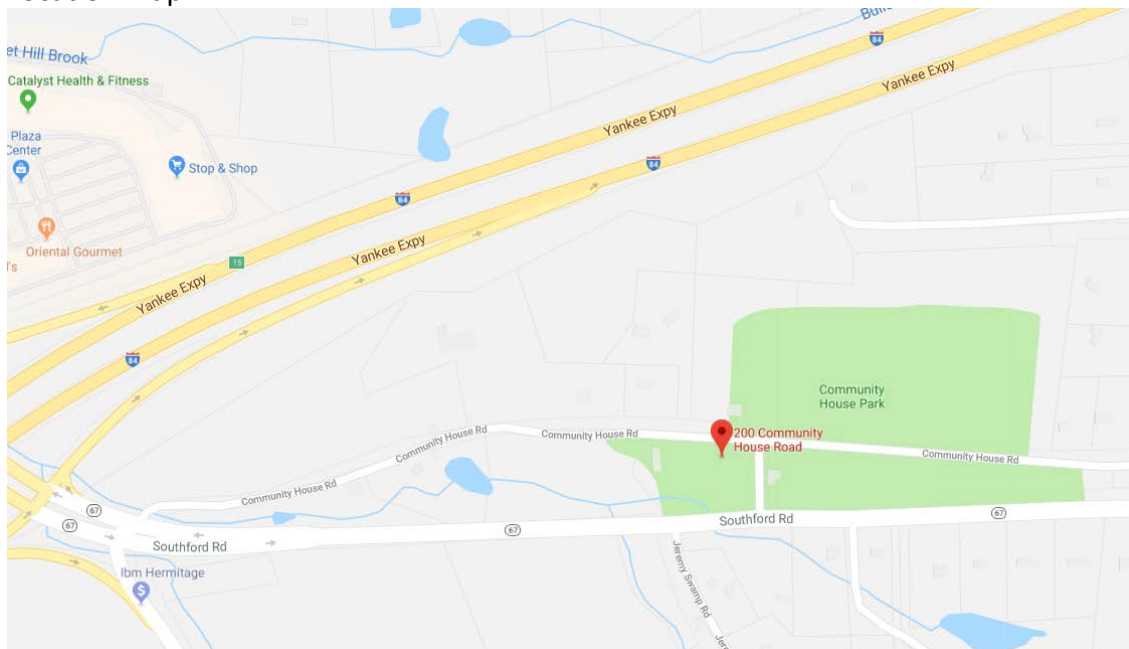
However, we know that water service is essential and are offering the water station to those in the community who are not our customers but rely on their own private wells so do not have water because of the widespread power outage.

The filling stations will be open as long as there is a need, and will be self-service.

People will need to bring their own containers. We encourage people to use only clean, safe containers for water that will be used for drinking, food preparation, brushing teeth, etc. Any container is fine if the water is to be used for filling toilets or other purposes where it will not be consumed.
