

## Important Information for Connecticut Water customers of the Hebron Center and Mill at Stonecroft water systems in Hebron

This is a reminder that Connecticut Water continues to ask customers of these water systems to conserve water.

Customers conserving water in the home and avoiding outdoor use, such as lawn watering, will help us extend the supplies in our system so we can continue to meet customers' needs and provide for fire protection for businesses and residents on the system.

As we mentioned in a call earlier this week, we have seen the amount water available to the water system reduced substantially because of decreased output from our primary groundwater source for the water system.

The decline in water production from our source is being investigated and we are in the process of evaluating both short term and long term options for additional sources of supply, but this will take time. In the meantime, we are asking for your help to reduce your water usage to extend the available supplies.

You can be assured that the water being delivered from the system to customers' meets all water quality standards and is safe to drink.

We will be mailing more information to you over the next week an update of what we have learned from our investigation of the situation as well as specific water conservation tips.
