

Shenipsit Lake Reservoir Fishing Program

All individuals, 16 years and older must possess a current valid CT fishing license. Individuals under the age of sixteen must be accompanied by an adult at least sixteen years of age with a valid fishing license.

Participants shall:

- Have all required licenses, permits, and any prerequisite training prior to participating
- Practice social distancing maintaining at least 6 feet separation between participants and limit congregating in common areas.

Boats/vessels of any type	Pets not leashed on dry land
Swimming or wading in reservoir or tributaries	Motor bikes or any motorized vehicles or vessels
Fishing in restricted area	Fires
Littering	Camping
Smoking	Removal of vegetation, animals, or minerals
Alcoholic Beverages	Vendors
Allowing vehicles or trailers to enter reservoir or tributaries	Disposal or discharge of wastes or other substances into any reservoir or tributary
Hunting or trapping	Bicycles
Horses	Carrying or discharge of firearms or weapons
Cleaning fish within 250 feet of any waterbody	Activities of any type on the ice of a frozen reservoir or tributaries
