Section of Deming Street in South Windsor to be closed beginning Thursday, July 29 Necessary for water main installation project

South Windsor, Conn. — July 27, 2021 — Beginning on Thursday, July 29, 2021, Deming Street in South Windsor between Buckland Road and Slater Street will be closed to thru traffic during the hours of 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Motorists will not be able to use Deming Street as a thru travel route. Local travel by residents and school buses will be allowed and driveway access will be maintained.

Traffic will be directed to Oakland Road to bypass the construction area. The detour route is expected to be in place through September 15th so that 2,400 feet of water main, or nearly one-half mile, can be installed. The entire project is expected to be completed by the end of October.

“The new pipe will improve water system reliability and increase the flow of water available to fire hydrants,” stated Craig J. Patla, Connecticut Water’s vice president, Service Delivery.

The establishment of a detour, as compared to a partial road closure, will allow the project to be completed as quickly and safely as possible.
